Peanut/Nut Free Facility Please be reminded that we are a **peanut/nut free facility**. Please avoid sending food with nuts to school as we do have some students with severe allergies. Thank you for your cooperation.

Student Absences When your child is absent from school, please notify the school in the morning before 9:00 a.m. by calling (306) 778-9292 or emailing jhackney52@chinooksd.ca. Message manager is available for leaving messages as well. If your child comes to school late, or you are picking them up early, please come to the office to sign them in/out.

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Communication Please remember to notify your child's homeroom teacher when there is a change in plans in picking your child up after school. If you have not contacted your child's homeroom teacher prior to 8:00 a.m. on the day, please call the office or email Mrs. Hackney, jhackney52@chinooksd.ca, and she will be sure to communicate the change of plans to the homeroom teacher. A phone call or note to the bus driver, as well as the school, to indicate a change of plans. (ie child is not going home on the bus.)

For your child's safety, we cannot take a student's word about a change of plans without confirmation from the parent/guardian. Various teachers are dismissing the students from their homerooms so it is important that the school is made aware of any changes early in the day to avoid confusion for your child. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

Indoor and Outdoor Shoes All students are required to have 2 pairs of shoes at school. One for outdoor and another clean pair for indoors. At this time of year, many students come to school wearing sandals. Please send a pair of socks with your child to wear in their indoor shoes. Thank you!

Please note that it is the responsibility of parents/guardians to arrange their childs transportation to & from extra-curricular events.

GUEST RIDERSHIP



If your child/children will be riding a bus that is not their own, or intends to have a guest ride the bus, contact must be made with the office. Both, the parent sending their child on the bus as well as the family inviting the child must contact the office via email, or phone prior to afternoon recess at 1:55 p.m. as a guest ridership form must be filled out and signed by Admin prior to boarding the bus. If the bus driver does not receive this form from the office, your child will not be able to be a guest on another bus.

Early Pick-Up **Policy**




School Pictures Monday, September 9th

This also ensures that students are under safe supervision in their designated classroom instead of waiting outside or in the fover if their pick up is delayed, as well confirming the identity of who is picking up your child.

This policy is in place to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all of our students at Waldeck School.




TERRY FOX

- 5. Place your child's lunch order(s) on your school's ordering calendar by clicking the blue date for the scheduled vendors.
